

VNC Connection How-to-do

Log in to the account you wish to service (UNIX) and type

```
# vncserver
```

This will create a new vnc session incrementing the session number
xray.chem.tamu.edu:2 xray.chem.tamu.edu:3 and so on.

The first time you start vncserver as a user it asks you to create a password. You must also edit the configuration file to turn on X. vi
/home/username/.vnc/xstartup uncomment the two lines that it says to uncomment and then you need to restart vnc.

To kill the service type

```
# vncserver -kill :2 or whichever session number you wish to kill.
```

Then restart vncserver.

```
# vncserver
```
